#### • Course objective and format:

Travel Study to China equips students with an understanding of the social, cultural, economic, and political environments of doing business in East Asia, with a special emphasis on China. Through preparatory lectures, overseas travel, readings and projects, students will learn about the challenges and critical success factors facing businesses in the region and how these issues are similar to and different from those in the U.S.

This course also provides a comprehensive foundation for understanding, managing, and successfully interacting in the multi-faceted, culturally-embedded contexts of today's multinational firms. The world as a "global village" is used so often that the phrase itself has become a cliché especially here in the cultural melting pot of Los Angeles. The aim of this course is to provide students with 1) an understanding of the major issues facing multinational corporations in the management of their international operations—particularly those of an intercultural nature; 2) insights into the cultural, historical and institutional factors influencing management practices around the world; and 3) the knowledge and ability to work effectively in multicultural teams.

### College Level Learning Goals and Expected Learning Outcomes

- Domestic and Globalization: Students will engage with and value different cultures in business and management when travelling abroad
- Team and Interpersonal Skills: Students will collaborate with each other to effectively deliver projects that emphasize localization for customers and globalization for operations
- Communication Skills: Students will effectively communicate, in both oral and written form, with international customers and managers.
- Ethics: Students will utilize managerial skills to engage ethically with local business

### Grading Policy based on 100% scale

- 20% --- Individual presentation before traveling (20 minutes each)
- 20% --- Group project progress presentation (20 minute presentation, research outcome as for what has been done in this project)
- 20% -- Job performance during the travel
- 20% --- Group activities in culture experience when traveling in China (Entertainment and activities)

- Each group may choose one of the following topics for your group presentation/project
  - American products or services looking for market opportunities in China such as GM or FORD investment in China
  - Compare the difference between American chain stores in China and the US such as the MacDonald's and KFC
  - Chinese products or services looking for market opportunities in the US such as furniture manufacturing, toy manufacturing, OEM, ODM and satellite launch services.
