1-1 Support for Your Child

Camp Nugget is designed to provide instruction on at least a four-to-one child/staff ratio. For the majority of children, this ratio has been very effective as the staff is trained to teach children with disabilities. We understand that your child may need to be redirected or the skill tasked analyzed.

It is the parents' responsibility to provide a 1-1 assistant with their child if their child requires intense one-on-one instruction. This also includes the swimming portion of camp. For example if your child:

- (a) will run away from the group
- (b) Has such a severe disability that he/she requires full-time physical assistance, including hand over on hand assistance **at all times**.

Thank you for your cooperation in this matter. A one-to-one ratio of one staff member to each to child would increase the registration cost of the camp, making a majority of parents unable to afford to attend.
