

Road map for LBCC students on CSULB BSN track

This roadmap is intended as a guide for the ADN student to better prepare for the BSN program at CSULB. By completing these courses, the student will likely meet the requirements for having their general education (GE) courses certified. In order to qualify for transfer, the student must apply to CSULB before November 30th for fall and August 31st for spring. The student must also have completed the following:

- Oral Communications/Speech
- English Composition
- Critical Thinking
- Statistics
