Updates from Colleges

- Library opening of second floor! Impact of damage on library materials.
- Certificate in Business Analytics update on this certificate offering, as Add On to other degree.
- Lead in Water university is still in process of testing fountains. 130 water fountains have been tested to date.
- Job Fair (representation of 4-7 sites) in March with focus on jobs in science education. Updates to be sent to C. Grutzik to share with school districts.
- Increase in MSCP applicants (somewhat due to change in Liberal Studies waver).
 Discussion on market impact for educators focus being in central valley and northern California. Also, student enrollment decrease in SoCal area.

- 4 year graduation focus in College of the Arts. Window Sculpture partnership for conservation (with Getty),
- Art Conservation Project multi disciplinary program that will utilize arts, science, etc. In development process at this stage.
- Garden Grove School District Education Specialist Credential Program pathway for paraprofessionals
- HIS Teacher Prep Grants for Single Subject preparation and mentorship– increased pathways for undergraduate (9 pathways). Partnership between undergrand/grad to mentors for those educating predominantly Hispanic students.
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Education Update – C. Grutzik

- Education pathways are interactive and intentional.
 - Educorps emphasis on identifying undergrad candidates who could be nominated as potential teachers.
- Dashboard for CA
 - Replacement for API score historically used to include a variety of data points/indicators. Data used to support District plan for LCAP.
 - Uses of this data to help guide pathway work from high school to college ready.
 - Discussion of usability of data and possible limitations
- Integrated Teacher Prep Program recipients
 - Numerous awards for 4 year integrated teacher ed pathways.
 - CSULB received multiple awards for our different options.
 - Discussion of impact of this on California prepared candidates
