DEAD WEEK AND THE TWO-DAY STUDY PERIOD

The two-day study period before Final Examinations shall consist of two full days, exclusive of Saturday, Sunday, and Holidays, to fall between the last day of instruction and the beginning of the final examination period. No academic work of any kind may be assigned or required by faculty during this period.

Furthermore, academic Dead Week shall be eliminated because of the inclusion in each semester's schedule of a two-day study period. Any academic exercise except the true course final examination may be given during the week prior to the two-day study period. Final examinations for all courses shall be given during the scheduled Final Examination Period. Exceptions to this must be arranged through appropriate school policies and procedures.
