

POLICY STATEMENT APPROVEDGENERAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS (Revision)

Page 72 of the General Bulletin, Category II, should read:

Two or more courses (totaling six or more units) in the departments of anthropology, economics, geography, history, political science, psychology, social welfare, or sociology, exclusive of any courses chosen to satisfy the requirements of U.S. History, Government and Constitution, included in Category V.

(This revision adds Social Welfare to the list).

Page 72 of the General Bulletin, Category III, should read:

Two or more courses (totaling six or more units). One of these must be either a philosophy course (offered by the Department of Philosophy), a religious studies course (offered by the Area of Religious Studies), or a literature course offered by one of the following departments: English, Comparative Literature, French-Italian, German, Classics or Eastern Languages, or Spanish-Portuguese.

(This revision adds Religious Studies to the listing).
