ASSIGNMENTS, TEACHING

<u>DELETE</u> Guidelines 7 and 8, from the Assignments, Teaching Section of the Faculty Handbook, which read as follows:

- 7. In the event of conflict of preferences, a faculty member of senior rank, or who has seniority within the same rank, may elect six semester hours of courses from among those he has taught during the preceding four years. However, not more than one course selected may be a graduate level course. The department chairman will assign the remaining course load with the understanding that one course within the total teaching load of the faculty member will be a lower division course.
- 8. Those courses specifically selected by the faculty member in the face of competing claims on the basis of the privilege of seniority may not be the same courses for more than two academic years without the concurrence of the department chairman.
