Subject: GRADUATE CERTIFICATE PROGRAM IN LEISURE COUNSELING

Admission/Prerequisites:

Persons holding a bachelor's or master's degree in Recreation or Therapeutic Recreation or a closely related allied health field, e.g., Occupational Therapy, Music Therapy, Gerontology, Psychology, Adapted Physical Education, Counseling.

Two years verified experience in counseling approved by the program advisor.

Certificate Requirements:

1. Satisfactory completion of 25 units of coursework which must include:

- a. Recreation 402/502, 411, 503, 588, 590;
- b. Educational Psychology 434, 532, 533;
- c. Electives, selected in consultation with the program advisor, 3 units.
