POLICY STATEMENT APPROVED

AS(GC)73-25

CERTIFICATE PROGRAMS AND GRADUATE STUDY

Students, whether graduates of CSULB or another accredited institution, at the baccalaureate level may work for and be awarded certificates for which they complete requirements while in graduate standing.

When certificate programs so provide, 500/600 level courses (except 698) may be used toward the requirements of such certificates. Prerequisites for these courses must be completed prior to registration in 500/600 level courses.

Courses used to meet the requirements for Master's Degree may also be used to meet certificate requirements when the certificate programs so permit, but such overlap shall not exceed 15 units.

Any Certificate Program that requires or permits graduate courses must receive the approval of the Graduate Council.
