SUBJECT: CERTIFICATE PROGRAM IN OUTDOOR STUDIES

The following policy statement, recommended by the Academic Senate at its meeting of December 11, 1980, and approved by the President on January 16, 1981, is as follows:

This program is designed to develop leaders who can provide safe and challenging situations for individuals seeking self-fulfilling experiences in outdoor environments. The program of study will enable the student to acquire appropriate knowledges and skills, and to develop a personal philosophy reflecting understanding and concern for the protection of the environment and safety of participants in outdoor activities.

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE CERTIFICATE IN OUTDOOR STUDIES

1. Certification in cardiopulmonary resuscitation and first aid.
2. Coursework
