SUBJECT: CERTIFICATE IN JAPANESE

The following policy statement recommended by the Academic Senate at its meeting of January 29, 1981, and approved by the President on February 24, 1981, as follows:

The Certificate Program in Japanese offers students an opportunity to develop spoken and written competency in modern Japanese and to acquire a broad introduction to various aspects of traditional and modern Japan.

The program is designed for students who intend to pursue a career in the private or public sectors, for which knowledge of Japan and command of the language is useful or necessary, and also for students who intend to pursue a graduate program in which such knowledge and competency are required.

Requirements for the Certificate in Japanese:

- i. A bachelor's degree (may be earned concurrently with the certificate).
- 2. 15 units of 400 level Japanese language courses.
- 3. If units of related upper division work from at least two disciplines. These units must be approved by a member of the advisory committee.
