The Center for Community Engagement (CCE) is accepting applications for a **CCE Faculty Curriculum Development Fellow** to support faculty in the integration of service learning into new or existing courses. The Curriculum Development Fellow will facilitate a curriculum development workshop series during the Spring, 2020 semester which will result in complete, approved service learning syllabi, the identification of community partners, and SL course implementation plans for each of the workshop participants.

Opportunities are arising for the CCE to address community engagement and community-based learning in new and innovative ways this coming AY 2019-20. With values and campus priorities emerging from Imagine Beach 2030, the CCE is well-positioned to continue advancing the public good, upholding social justice and equity, and empowering students for success. As a part of these efforts, a CCE-UROP faculty-led team will be working to pilot a General Education Community Engagement concentration; a CCE Data Fellows project on the impact of community engagement will be initiated; and several faculty will be incorporating Service Learning and/or other types of community-based learning and research through externally funded projects.

Faculty Curriculum Development Fellow

Specific Responsibilities:

- In close coordination with CCE staff, review and, when necessary, update the curriculum development workshop structure, multi-media learning modules and other materials, and the workshop syllabus.
- Facilitate a series of discussion- and activity-based curriculum development workshops (generally 4 or 5 workshops lasting approximately 2 hours each) that are tied into readings and topical, multi-media learning modules that participants complete prior to each workshop.
- Guide the progress of each participant to insure completion and approval of syllabi by the end of the workshop series.
- Review existing service learning course syllabi and provide recommendations for revisions if needed.
- Outreach and advocacy for service learning/community engagement.

Qualifications:

- Strong understanding of curriculum design, including development of learning objectives and outcomes and assessment of learning outcomes.
- Familiarity with campus policy and procedures around course design, including those relating to Standard Course Outlines (SCO).
- Past participation in CCE curriculum development workshops.
- Experience in developing and teaching service learning courses, consistent with service learning best practices.
- Experience utilizing *S4 @ The Beach* database.
