<b>Fee Name</b>	Nursing Sim Lab Course Fee
<b>Purpose of the Fee</b>	to pay for additional consumable lab supplies used in each lab section
<b>Detailed Fee Description</b>	The Sim Lab Course Fee was originated in 1999 to pay for materials used in the lab sections of NRSG 200 and NRSG 250. The fee was approved and set at \$40. It is included in the registration fees charged to each student enrolling in the class.
<b>Reason for Changing</b>	Since the inception of the course fee in 1999, curriculum changes have increased the number of lab sections utilizing the simulation labs, which require supplies. While re-utilization of purchased materials is heavily adhered to, new regulations require each nursing student to demonstrate their skills before being allowed to work on the medical unit, including testing of the use of supplies that are un-opened and in its original packaging so the student can demonstrate their knowledge of sterile technique. Additionally, the number of students admitted into both the undergraduate and graduate programs has increased and the sheer volume of students using the re-utilized materials means that they also need to be replaced on a more regular schedule due to wear. Students can purchase the supplies on their own if they wish; there are several vendors available that sell medical supplies to individuals. However, the supplies can be extremely costly. The School of Nursing gets more cost-effective pricing by purchasing the items in bulk quantities and does utilize a variety of vendors in order to get the supplies at the lowest price possible.




