## EE202 Lab Grading Policy

Points will be deducted if the following basic instructions/rules are not followed.

- On any material you turn in always include your name, today's date, lab section and lab instructor (EE202-08 Hill), and lab number (Lab 1).
- Always write the question or an abbreviated version before you providing the answer.
- Copying lab solutions is not allowed. Be prepared to demonstrate your work in lab (this implies that you must attend lab).

Labs are worth from 20 to 30 pts each. Unless otherwise indicated labs are due at the beginning of the next lab period. If you turn in the lab, during the next lab period, 2 pts ( $10 \%$ of 20 pts) will be deducted until 15 minutes before the end of the lab period. After this time Labs will be considered 1 week late and prorated by 4 pts ( $20 \%$ of 20 pts). Labs which are 2 weeks late will be prorated by 6 pts (30\%). Labs will not be accepted after a two week period of time.

Some labs may include "bonus" or extra credit sections. As a result, it is plausible that you may receive over $100 \%$ as your final lab grade. As a result, if your final lab score is over $100 \%$; the percentage will be limited to $100 \%$ in the computation of the lab grade component of your final grade.
