
If you get a **hardback copy** of the 6th edition that does not say Hybrid, that would work too, but **it is so expensive**, even used, that I am not going to recommend it at all.

Textbook Buying Options

There are three things associated with the textbook: (1) the homework system called Enhanced WebAssign, the (2) ebook, and (3) the Hybrid paperback book.

- WebAssign is required (if you want to practice many textbook problems)
- The ebook is automatically included in WebAssign.
- The Hybrid paperback book SHOULD come with WebAssign (and the ebook). Make sure before you buy.

So you have two options:



Remarks:

- If you buy a used Hybrid book, or one without EWA access, you will have to buy the "Go Electronic" option to do your homework. This is usually more expensive than the bundle. So, I recommend buying the bundle with the new hybrid textbook if you have to have a physical copy of the book.
- You can access WebAssign for free for 2 weeks. At that point, you have
 to pay or enter an access code that you get in a bundle. (WebAssign
 Course Code for your class can be found in the Introduction to
 WebAssign file on the course website.)
