Alipur Sign Language (A Language of India)

- Location: a <u>village sign language</u> of India. It is spoken in the town of <u>Alipur</u>, <u>Karnataka</u>, which is a self-imposed Muslim enclave with a high degree of congenital deafness in a largely Hindu region.
- Language Use: A substantial number of the hearing population of 17,000 knows the language.
