## Mardin Sign Language (A Language of Turkey)

- <u>Location</u>: a <u>village sign language</u> of Turkey. It was originally spoken in the town of <u>Mardin</u>, dating back at least five generations in a single extended family.
- <u>Language Use:</u> All speakers now live in <u>Izmir</u> or <u>Istanbul</u>, and the younger generation has shifted to <u>Turkish Sign Language</u>.
