GOAL 2: Establish a comprehensive UAS Continuous Improvement Cycle that includes multiple sources of data, allows for equity, diversity, and inclusion (EDI)-informed analyses, and supports student learning and outcomes.

- 2.1. Develop and implement a data collection process of qualitative and quantitative data from CED, CHHS, and CPaCE programs, candidates and completers, and external stakeholders (i.e., P-12 school districts such as LBUSD and community colleges) to inform continuous program improvement.
- **2.2.** Establish a process for regular review and analysis of data that integrates an EDI lens, promotes transparency and accountability, and supports continuous program improvement.
- **2.3.** Provide resources and support to CED and CHHS programs to meet all accreditation and reporting requirements and college-wide goals and initiatives.
