Additional Information

1. FMD 253, FCSE 296, and CHEM 100 (fulfills G.E. Category B1b) or CHEM 111A (fulfills G.E. Category B1b) are prerequisites for FMD 353.
2. ECON 100 and 101 or ECON 300 (each ECON course mentioned fulfills G.E. Category D2), FMD 353, and senior standing, or consent of instructor are prerequisites for FMD 457.
3. FMD 353, senior standing, or consent of instructor are prerequisites for FMD 458.
4. Completion of GE Foundation courses, and ANTH 120 or SOC 100 or 142 (each ANTH and SOC course listed fulfills G.E. Category D2) and upper division standing or consent of instructor are prerequisites for FMD 450 (fulfills G.E. Category D2 and Global Issues).
5. FMD 351 is the prerequisite for FMD 451.
6. FMD 451 or 455 or 457 is a prerequisite for FMD 492E (refer to '10-'11 CSULB *Catalog* for additional prerequisite requirements for FMD 492E).
7. The minor in Textiles is available to any non-Fashion Merchandising and Design or any non-Textiles and Clothing major.
