10. PROJECT PROCESS AND DELIVERABLES: The text of the proposal must be prepared using 12-point type and 1-inch margins. Please do not use double spacing or a bold font. Accepted proposals will be announced by the Ukleja Center for Ethical Leadership in April 2023. Selected stipend recipients shall submit their research to a minimum of one (1) peer review journal with documentation provided to the Ukleja Center for Ethical Leadership by May 1, 2026. In addition, stipend recipients shall submit a 500-word summary of their research to the Ukleja Center for Ethical Leadership by May 1, 2026. Ethics research stipend recipients will also give a brief presentation of their research at a Ukleja Center for Ethical Leadership event. Selected ethics research recipients will receive the first half of their award (\$2,500 less payroll taxes and other payroll deductions) by July 1, 2023 and the remaining balance (\$2,500 less payroll taxes and other payroll deductions) after completing the aforementioned deliverables by July 1, 2026.
11. FACULTY HISTORY OVER THE LAST THREE YEARS: On **no more than 3 separate pages**, provide complete citations of journal articles, book chapters, conference presentations, and other intellectual contributions produced during the period covering from July 2019 to June 2022. Acknowledge co-authors (if any) and indicate whether each intellectual contribution is refereed or non-refereed. In addition, list all current and pending internal and external support for your proposed project.
12. COPYRIGHT: In consideration of the ethics research stipend awarded to the recipient by the Ukleja Center for Ethical Leadership, the award recipient hereby grants the Ukleja Center for Ethical Leadership a non-exclusive, royalty-free license to publish and republish the recipient's work product, including without limitation, book, digital, Internet, and other formats now existing or hereafter developed.
