PROGRAM NOTES

Frame Drumming

This work was developed to display basic techniques that may be applied to frame drums. The drums are played in vertical and horizontal positions with drumming influences from India, Indonesia, Africa, the Middle East, Ireland, and contemporary hybrid concepts. Mr. Engel will perform variations on the basic patterns on a frame drum from Mongolia known as gaval.

Atchia

Atchia comes from the Ewe people of Ghana in Western Africa and occurs as a part of a large social celebration. This drumming excerpt, in actual context would be accompanied by interchanging groups of people dancing and singing a variety of songs that may last for several days.
