ABOUT OLIVER CHAN

Oliver Chan earned his bachelor's and master's degrees at the UCLA Herb Alpert School of Music, where he studied under the tutelage of internationally acclaimed pianist Walter Ponce. Oliver has been a featured pianist, conductor, and music educator throughout the Greater Los Angeles Area.

Oliver is the music director of Opera Italia, an opera company based in Los Angeles, and a staff accompanist at the UCLA Herb Alpert School of Music, where he works closely with renowned baritone Vladimir Chernov. He has also worked as the assistant conductor at La Sierra University Opera Theatre, an accompanist at Santa Monica College, and the chorusmaster at Nuni Opera.

At the BCCM, Oliver conducts the Bob Cole Conservatory Symphony Orchestra and coaches voice students in the Opera Institute while pursuing his master's degree in orchestral conducting. He currently studies with Dr. Johannes Müller Stosch and has studied with Dr. Jacob Sustaita and Dr. Dean Anderson.

ABOUT JOSEPH CHANG

Joseph Chang is an emerging Canadian percussionist studying a Master of Music in Percussion Performance at California State University: Long Beach under Ted Atkatz. Joseph studied for a Bachelor of Music at McGill University under Fabrice Marandola, Kristie Ibrahim, Shawn Mativetsky, and Ben Reimer. Joseph's versatility has shown through his performances with CSULB and McGill's Symphony Orchestra, Wind Symphony, and Contemporary Music Ensemble. Joseph has also performed with the Longueuil Symphony Orchestra, Colburn Conservatory Orchestra, and Orange County Women's Chorus. His performance research collaborations include the Centre for Interdisciplinary Research in Music Media and Technology, Institut de Recherche et Coordination Acoustique/Music, and College Music Society.

In the summer months, Joseph returns to Montreal, where he works as the Principal Percussionist with the 438 Tactical Helicopter Squadron Band. His collaborations with the band over the past four years led him to serve many communities in Canada, including Halifax, Montreal, Ottawa, Quebec City, St Johns, Toronto, and Winnipeg. Joseph also performed with other Canadian Forces bands, including the Central Band of the Canadian Armed Forces, the Royal 22e Regiment Band, and the Royal Canadian Air Force Band.

Joseph dedicates his free time reorchestrating video game music for his *YouTube* channel. Joseph has steadily gained recognition in the field, giving panels in Music and Gaming West and Festival Conventions and lectures in CSULB of his reorchestration projects. Joseph hopes to study for a doctoral degree fusing digital signal processing and percussion to explain and categorize numerous percussion sounds synthesized in early video game music.
