 - i. Equity and Diversity will be working on an internal list over the summer. Can only publish ADA compliant, public, single stall restrooms, but can have list for use as needed.
 - 1. Will use this list as a starting point for students to search for more that can be added to this list or could be converted.
 - ii. Departments are not required to let Equity and Diversity know if they update their restrooms to comply.
