 - 2/5/18 Jo Brocato gave a presentation to the Commission on Inclusive Excellence regarding survey timeline and received positive attitudes towards committee progress; Commission wants to include survey results for improvements to build a more inclusive campus
 - Provost said parking incentive was doable
 - Questions were asked about how we would include the Foundation & community members (e.g. Life Fit and Life Long Learning Institute)
 - Nancy Torres, Interim AVP, HRM expressed concern regarding potential survey items that relate to construct of *satisfaction with working conditions* and potential concern from faculty union making policy out of survey response
 - A meeting with Misty, Nancy and Mark needs to be scheduled
 - CCC desire to increase response rate vs. random sampling
 - Office of Equity and Title IX need to review survey draft with series of iterations followed by pilot survey among CCC members

 - Steve Boyers shared highlights from the Faculty Affairs sponsored event on instructional free speech (ex. more restrictions on academic free speech than in the community at large “due to time, place & manners” clause; no video or audio recording allowed in class); bottom line- students and faculty need to be more informed regarding free speech rights and protection; there is a Center for First Amendment Studies in Communication department
 - Nielen Barnes reported summary from ATS workshop with her Sociology department; general concerns of how online learning affects student learning and issues of inclusive excellence and diverse learning communities, which are or are not addressed in online formats; questions regarding autonomy of course materials in an online teaching format
